Number of incidents that resulted in formal discipline- **3 incidents resulted in formal discipline.**

Types of disciplinary action taken- out of school suspensions - **(1)**, emergency removal **(2)** In School Suspension (0), ASI-(0) and conferences with the parents and students were held on all.

Steps to prevent and reduce incidents of bullying, harassment, and intimidation

- Provide information and resources to students and parents via the school webpage, including the Bullying Flow Chart
- Refer students to guidance counselor for working on peer relationships
- Use Athletic Director to inform Coaches and provide training
- Conference in person, over the phone, and through emails with parents
- Recommendations made for students to talk to counselor or seek counseling
- Use “Coaching Boys into Men” to help prevent future issues with HS boys
- Form Girls and Boys support groups
