Number of incidents reported and investigated -1 incident was verified and investigated

Number of incidents determined to be unsubstantiated -5 incidents were not verified or substantiated

Number of incidents requiring administrative action be taken -5 administrative actions were given on all incidents through investigation and counseling, even if the incident was not verified as bullying.

Number of incidents that resulted in formal discipline- 4 incidents resulted in formal discipline.

Types of disciplinary action taken (all- either verified or not verified as Bullying) out of school suspensions - (3), emergency removal (3), ASI-(1) and conferences with the parents and students were provided on all incidents.

Steps to prevent and reduce incidents of bullying, harassment, and intimidation-

- Provide information and resources to students and parents via the school webpage, including the Bullying Flow Chart.
- Continued a positive behavior reward system at the high school called the Spartan Star Card
- Referred students to guidance counselor for working on peer relationships
- Conferenced in person, over the phone, and through emails with parents
- Referrals to Solutions were made in order for in-school therapy to take place when needed for students
- Girls only support group was continued
- Anti-Bullying bulletin board was created and is on display
- Mix-it-up Day was sponsored during a lunch to increase the awareness about diversity and tolerance.
