Documented Bullying Report **August 2020 - December 2020 (Students did not return to school until September 2020 due to COVID)**

Building- **Waynesville High School**

Number of incidents reported and investigated- 2 incidents were reported and investigated

Number of incidents determined to be unsubstantiated -2 incidents were not verified or substantiated

Number of incidents determined to be substantiated – 0 incidents were verified and substantiated

Number of incidents requiring administrative action be taken -2

Administrative action was taken on all incidents through investigation and counseling, even if the incident was not verified as bullying.

Number of incidents that resulted in formal discipline- 2 incidents resulted in formal discipline

Types of disciplinary action taken:

2- After school Interventions and conference with the parents/student held

Steps to prevent and reduce incidents of bullying, harassment, and intimidation

- Refer students to guidance counselor or mental health consultant for mentoring and guidance
- Conference in person, over the phone, and through emails with parents
- Sometimes mediation meetings are scheduled
- Guidance counselor organizes bulletin boards to promote anti-bullying messages throughout the building
- Information and discussions are provided during “Connect Period”. Connect student leaders and guidance counselor have developed videos to initiate discussion in Connect.
