Steps taken to prevent and reduce incidents of bullying, harassment, and intimidation:

- Provide resources to parent/students via website, Good News Friday, and Quarterly Newsletter
- Monitor students' behavior in "hot spots" during peak times
- Address concerns to students through brief meetings in gym and cafeteria
- Continue Spartan Star Card program to reward positive behavior
- Administrator/Guidance Counselor to assist students in conflict resolution
- Hold REDO day with sixth and seventh graders –January 30 and 31, 2017
- Use wall space in the middle school to promote positive behaviors
- Meet with parents and students as needed
