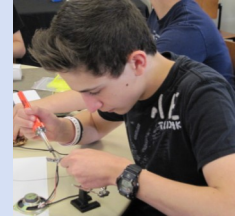


## SINCLAIR RASPBERRY PI CAMP

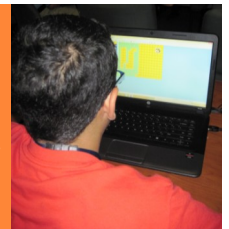
## TECH CAMP II
