IMPORTANT DATES:

<u>Registration Two Night Event</u>: In Elementary Media Center, this initial part of the process will take approximately 15-20 minutes to complete as long as Final Forms has already been completed online. The following are those dates and times:

Kindergarten Screening Dates

Location: Quaker Heights Community Room March 24th & 25^{th,} 2020 8:00 am to 3:00 pm (30 minute appointments) Specific appointments for each child will be made <u>ONLY</u> upon completed registration.

Kindergarten Open House: August 13, 2020 5:00-6:00 pm Elementary Gymnasium

KRA Testing

Location: Quaker Heights August 17th & 18th, 2020 Time: Appointments between 8:00 am and 3:00 pm

- Appointments are in 30 minute increments.
- Parents will schedule a time for their child's KRA in early August immediately following the notification of teacher assignment.

Documents that you need to bring to the registration event:

- Child's Original Birth Certificate
- Parent/Guardian Driver's License or Photo ID
- Immunization Records
- Custody / Guardianship Documents
- Proof of Residency
- We will have a copier on site for all original documents during the registration event!

Proof of Residency:

<u>Home Owners:</u> Bring Mortgage Statement or Deed <u>Renter or Lessee:</u> Bring signed official Rental Agreement <u>If Applicable:</u> Complete Time-stamped Custody Paperwork, IEP / 504 Plan / ETR

REQUIREMENT FOR ALL:

- ALL: need to bring current DP&L or Vectren bill for registration address.
- Certain circumstances will require Residence Affidavit

WES Kindergarten FAQ's

What is half day kindergarten?

The majority of WES kindergarten students will attend half day kindergarten. Morning Kindergarten is from 8:45-11:35. Afternoon Kindergarten is from 12:35-3:35.

What is Young Fives?

Candidates for this program will be identified through a consideration of the child's birthdate and in some cases, his or her screening score. The program is meant for students who are turning five closer to the cutoff date of September 30 and is designed to spread the kindergarten experience over two years.

What is Extended Day?

Extended day is meant to provide extra time for students who need intervention in order to move on to first grade with all the necessary skills to be successful. Candidates for this program will be identified through the child's screening score.

What is the KRA testing?

The KRA is state mandated and designed to assess a child's school readiness. It includes six components Social Skills, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Language and Literacy, Physical Well Being and Motor Development

When will I know my child's teacher & placement?

Parents will be informed of child's <u>placement</u> no later than June 30, 2020. <u>Teacher assignments</u> will be communicated no later than August 7, 2020. Both will be sent via email, please make sure we have a good working email on file for you.
