# Graduation Requirements

Class of 2023 and beyond must meet the new Ohio Graduation Requirements

**(Three key components)** Page 4 Program of Studies

1) **Course Credit Completion** – Credits mentioned in last slide

2) **Competency Demonstration**

Students will demonstrate competency in the foundational areas of : **English Language Arts (ELA2)** & **Mathematics (Algebra I)**

*End of Course score needed for both courses (Exam) – Raw Score of **684** ( Basically a high 2)*

3) **Readiness Demonstration**

Students must **also show they are prepared for college or careers.** Ohio law created **seals** for students to demonstrate academic, technical & professional readiness for careers, college, the military or self-sustaining professions. Seals help students develop an array of critical skills that are valuable to them as they transition to the next steps after high school.

Students will demonstrate readiness by **earning at least TWO seals,** 1 of which must be **STATE** defined.

# ACADEMIC HONORS DIPLOMA *Page 6 Program of Studies*

**CRITERIA:** Students must meet **all but one** of the following criteria:

**4 credits** of MATH , including Algebra I\*, Geometry, and Algebra II, & one other **higher level course**

**4 credits** of SCIENCE including **2 credits of advanced science** (inquiry based/lab courses)

**4 credits** of SOCIAL STUDIES

**3 credits** of a FOREIGN LANGUAGE or 2 credits each of two languages\*, courses must be sequential

**1 credit** of FINE ARTS

Cumulative **UNWEIGHTED GPA of 3.5** on a 4.0 scale, through the first semester of senior year

A composite score of at least **27 on the ACT** or at least **1280 on the SAT** (writing sections not included)

\*Foreign language and Algebra taken in Grade 8 may count toward these criteria.
