Applications for the **Warren County Music Club Scholarship** are now available. Applications have been sent to all Warren County public high schools. Students can check with their Guidance Office to obtain a copy.

History: The Warren County Music Club is a member of the Ohio Federation of Music Clubs, which is dedicated to maintaining high musical standards by promoting scholarships and performances. The Warren County Music Club sponsors monthly concerts and offers an annual, one-year scholarship of \$1000 to a deserving Warren County music student.

Eligibility: The scholarship application process is open to any Warren County resident who is a high school senior (or current college music major) pursuing a degree in music performance or music education at an accredited college or university as a full-time student.

Timeline: Applications are due by March 1, 2018. All students will be notified by April 25, 2018 as to the status of their candidacy. Scholarship winners will be invited to receive a presentation of their award at the May concert of the Warren County Music Club.
